Our flagship wine, named after legendary Houghton Winemaker Jack Mann, who presided over winemaking for 51 consecutive vintages.

### GRAPE VARIETY

Cabernet Sauvignon

### COLOUR

Dark purple/red with a bright scarlet hue

### NOSE

A dense and concentrated bouquet of dark forest fruits, blackberry, plum skin, and dark chocolate characters with a subtle overlay of bay leaf, tobacco and wild mint. High quality French oak completes the picture. A wonderful concentrated expression of Cabernet.

### PALATE

A full flavoured, rich, and sumptuously layered wine with intensity, power and presence. The dense, firm, fine grained tannin is beautifully integrated with the fruit and oak providing a seamless palate. Outstanding intensity, structure and balance will ensure a long cellaring life.

### VINEYARD REGION

Frankland River

### VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The 2019 vintage in Frankland River was characterised by persistent cool and dry conditions leading into a later than average commencement to harvest. The Justin Vineyard produced a low yielding crop with intensity of flavour and fine, firm tannins.
